



VERMEJO PRONGHORN HUNTS

PREMIUM PRONGHORN

- Vermejo offers 3-day pronghorn hunts that occur in late August and early September.
- August is at the end of the monsoon season for New Mexico. Hunters should be prepared for heat and bugs as environmental factors of the hunt.
- Vermejo maintains a reasonably healthy pronghorn population with a herd being managed to provide a favorable buck to doe ratio for quality animals.
- Our bucks are representative of those found in this region of New Mexico which tend to not grow as large as some other areas in the state.
- A hunter can expect the average hunt to have opportunities at mid-70" (B&C gross) class bucks.
- A premium hunt includes targeting mature (3 years or older) bucks taking any mature buck he/she chooses. Expect a spot and stalk style hunt with shots ranging from 100 to 300 yards.
- All hunts are performed from a modern, 4x4 vehicle* with experienced Vermejo hunt guides, who we try to pair with hunters based on the needs and abilities of our hunting guests.
- Pronghorns have excellent eyesight, so come prepared to hunt in wide open terrain offering little to no cover if you hope to best one of these wary animals.
- Expect travel time as the portion of the property pronghorn inhabit is typically 1 hour from lodging at Headquarters. This is, however, a great way to get to experience the variety of habitats and wildlife Vermejo has to offer.
